SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Our College is a place that inspires our community. The Summit Netball Scholarships are available to students who demonstrate dedication, teamwork, resilience, and a passion for netball. These scholarships are designed for students who take pride in representing themselves, their team, and the College both on and off the court.

Summit Netball Scholarship recipients will embrace opportunities to develop their skills, strive to achieve their personal best, and contribute positively to the College's netball culture. They will demonstrate strong sportsmanship, commitment, and a willingness to engage in a broad range of netball and school activities while maintaining their emotional, social, and physical wellbeing.

Baringa State Secondary College, in conjunction with the Parents and Citizens' Association, is offering Summit Netball Scholarships to students enrolling in Year 7 in 2027. These scholarships recognise students who have demonstrated commitment to netball through school and community involvement, consistently display positive attitudes and behaviours, and serve as role models to their peers. Applicants are not required to hold formal leadership positions; however, they should demonstrate leadership qualities through their actions, teamwork, dedication, and contribution to their sporting community.

Successful applicants will embody the values of the Summit Netball Program and show the potential to make a positive impact both on the court and within the College community.

Scholarship recipients will be announced at Awards Night on **Wednesday 18 November 2026**.

CRITERIA

To be awarded a scholarship students must:

- The applicant will demonstrate the College values of Respect, Integrity and Courage as well as the broad range of opportunities they have taken to increase their emotional, physical and social wellbeing and this of others.

Candidates will be selected on the basis of the following and should be attached to this application:

- ☐ Complete the written application.
- ☐ Create a video (using iMovie) that is no longer than 2 minutes that demonstrates the students aptitude to be a confident, creative or aspirational sports person.
 - examples of how you demonstrate the College values;
 - how you contribute to Netball in the College/School and/or the community you are currently in;
 - your willingness to engage with a broad range of opportunities and what this would look like.

- Demonstrate a commitment to the College core values – Respect, Integrity and Courage;
- Support for all aspects of the College's Uniform Policy reflected by wearing the College uniform with pride;
- Demonstrate a commitment to the pursuit of excellence, reflected in their effort and behaviour; and
- Willingness to engage with a broad range of opportunities.
