SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Our College is a place that inspires our community. The scholarships for our *Leaders of Tomorrow* are available to students who are confident, creative and aspirational. They are for students who have a deep sense of pride for themselves and the College. Our *Leaders of Tomorrow* Scholarship recipients will embrace learning and achieve their potential whilst strengthening their emotional, social and physical wellbeing. The student will have a willingness to engage with a broad range of opportunities.

Baringa State Secondary College in conjunction with the Parents and Citizen's Association is offering scholarships to students enrolling in Year 7 in 2026 and current Year 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 and 12 students. These scholarships reward students who have strived to achieve academically (but do not have to be a straight A/B students), are good role models to their peers/others in society and who are active participants in community, sporting and/or cultural activities. They do not have to engage in a leadership position at the College, however, need to demonstrate leadership in their chosen field. The student will show attributes of a future leader.

Scholarships offered to students are valued to cover the Student Resource Scheme.

Scholarship winners will be announced at Awards Night on Wednesday 19 November.

CRITERIA

To be awarded a scholarship students must:

- Students must be in catchment and have completed the enrolment process and had an interview with the Principal or be currently enrolled in the school (Years).
- The applicant will demonstrate the College values of Respect, Integrity and Courage as well as the broad range of opportunities they have taken to increase their emotional, physical and social wellbeing and this of others.

Candidates will be selected on the basis of the following and should be attached to this application:

Complete the written application.

Create a video (using iMovie) that is no longer than 2 minutes that demonstrates the

students aptitude to be a confident, creative or aspirational learner. This could include;

- examples of how you demonstrate the College values;
- how you contribute to the College/School and/or the community you are currently in;
- your willingness to engage with a broad range of opportunities and what this would look like.

Applications must be submitted to the Administration Office no later than 3:00 pm on Friday 31 October 2025. Please have the 3 requirements saved to a USB to be transferred onto our system.

SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENT EXPECTATIONS

- Demonstrate a commitment to the College core values Respect, Integrity and Courage;
- Support for all aspects of the College's Uniform Policy reflected by wearing the College uniform with pride;
- Demonstrate a commitment to the pursuit of excellence, reflected in their effort and behaviour; and
- Willingness to engage with a broad range of opportunities.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Applications must be submitted no later than 3pm on Friday 31 October 2025.

- Applications will be processed by administration and forwarded to the Scholarship Panel for decision once all application requirements have been met.
- Applicants parent/carer will be contacted via email with the outcome of their application.
- Successful students and their parent/carer will be invited to Awards Night on Wednesday 19 November 2025.
