# Application for the Academic Scholarship

## SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM OVERVIEW

### What is the Summit Program?

The Summit Program is a course for academically talented Junior Secondary School Students in Year 7 to better meet their needs, ensuring they develop intellectually and reach their full potential.

The Summit Program allows highly motivated students to be grouped together so they can be challenged and encouraged by their peers to work hard and continue to succeed in their studies. Students may work at a higher level or faster pace and will also be challenged to develop higher order thinking skills. This program will assist in preparing students for their senior years of schooling and continue to engage them and enhance their love of learning.

Scholarship winners will be notified directly and invited to announced at Awards Night on Wednesday 18 November 2026.

## CRITERIA

To be awarded a scholarship students must:

- Students must be achieving and maintain a grade point average of 4.5 and above for English, Maths, Science and Humanities. Results in Japanese, Physical Education and Arts/Technology electives may be taken into consideration;
- Students must be achieving and maintaining an “excellent” or “very good” on their report card for behaviour and effort;
- Home study in all classes must be completed to a satisfactory standard; and Students must meet and maintain the Good Standing.

☐ Create a video (using iMovie) that is no longer than 2 minutes that demonstrates the students aptitude to be a confident, creative or aspirational learner. This could include;

- examples of how you demonstrate the College values;
- how you contribute to the College/School and/or the community you are currently in;
- your willingness to engage with a broad range of opportunities and what this would look like.

## SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENT EXPECTATIONS

- Demonstrate a commitment to the College core values – Respect, Integrity and Courage;
- Support for all aspects of the College’s Uniform Policy reflected by wearing the College uniform with pride;
- Demonstrate a commitment to the pursuit of excellence, reflected in their effort and behaviour; and
- Willingness to engage with a broad range of opportunities.
